**Position Description:** The Greater Mahale Ecosystem Research and Conservation (GMERC) Project is seeking a Tanzanian, female research assistant to collect botanical data as part of a larger project on wild chimpanzee feeding ecology in the Greater Mahale Ecosystem, western Tanzania for 7 months beginning in May 2023. Responsibilities include (1) Leading data collection of chimpanzee feeding tree characteristics, (2) assisting with project design and data processing, (3) assisting with community outreach in local schools. The successful candidate will receive mentoring in research skills from the project lead, and have the opportunity to produce a poster on their work.

**Qualifications:** We are looking for female-only Tanzanian candidates, who must be passionate about research, responsible, organized, independent, resourceful, and get along well and easily with others, as the position requires long periods in the field with Tanzanians and expats. Flexibility is critical as often scheduling, etc. change at the last minute! Knowledge of basic first aid is very useful.
